2. 10th European Maya Conference 2005

Leiden University (Faculty of Archaeology, CNWS) and the National Museum of Ethnology at Leiden (The Netherlands) will be hosting the 10^{th} European Maya Conference from $5^{th} - 10^{th}$ of December 2005. The conference will combine a workshop on Maya hieroglyphic writing (December $5^{th} - 8^{th}$) and a two-day long symposium (Friday, December 9^{th} – Saturday, December 10^{th}).

The theme of the EMC 2005 will be *The Maya and their Neighbours. Internal and External Contacts Through Time*.

Keynote speakers will include: Erik Boot, Nikolai Grube, Maarten Jansen, Simon Martin, Ruud van Akkeren, and Marc Zender.

CALL FOR PAPERS

The Wayeb Conference Board invites the submission of abstracts concerning the conference topic. Papers will be selected from all subdisciplines of Maya Studies. Presentations will be accepted in English and Spanish. Abstracts may not exceed 250 words. Contributions of authors who submit more than one abstract will not be considered. Co-authorships need to be indicated on submission.

- 3. Title of Paper
- 4. Abstract

The abstracts will be forwarded without the author's particulars to an anonymous Review Committee that will be selected by the WAYEB Conference Board.

Deadline for receipt of abstracts is 30 June, 2005.
